The annual congress hosted by SASPEN and the Critical Care Society of Southern Africa Congress (CCSSA) was hosted with great excitement as an "inperson event" on 22–25 August 2024 at the Sandton Convention Centre in Johannesburg. The congress featured local and international speakers with vast expertise in the field of clinical nutrition. Delegates had the opportunity to attend ESPEN LLL (Life-Long Learning) workshops on different topics and the program included exiting pre-congress workshops.

The SASPEN recognition awards was presented at the CCSSA Congress for contributions in the field of clinical nutrition:

- The Award for best oral presentation at the 2024 congress was awarded to Lizl Veldsman for her work on "the effect of intravenous bolus amino acid supplementation on plasma amino acid concentrations over 24 hours from baseline".
- The Arina Prins Award for best original research publication in an international journal went to Dr Marwyn Sowden for her publication on the "Effect of a multistrain probiotic on growth and time to reach full feeds in pre-term neonates".
- The Arina Prins Award for the best publication for clinical nutrition in a national journal was awarded to Galya Chinnery for her publication "Early economic benefits of perioperative nasojejenal tube feeding in non-critical care adult surgical patients with gastric feed intolerance".
- The Arina Prins Award for the best clinical nutrition review article publication was awarded to Dr Janicke Visser for her article on "Prevalence and related assessment practices of adult hospital malnutrition: A scoping review".

- The Arina Prins Award for the best clinical nutrition publication for a case study went to Safiyah Hassan for her contribution on "The perioperative nutritional management of a Whipples patient".
- The SASPEN service award for exceptional contribution to the field of clinical nutrition, was awarded to the Groote Schuur Hospital Dietetics Department for their contribution to the continuous education to all dietitians through the establishment of a journal club.

The 2025 Congress will be hosted in Durban. We are looking forward to seeing familiar and new faces at the event.
